	Prof. Umesh assured the Council that the recommendations will be adequately addressed in the Curriculum as required in the higher semesters.

The Council advised that the question of how different and distinct is the B.Tech. Program as compared to many other Computer Science Programs be carefully addressed in order to better place this Program as a unique offering.

The Council was briefed that the University has a specific focus on the domain of Data Science. The Program name was in accordance with the Statutory prescription. However, the design and focus of the Curriculum was quite distinct with foundations in Data Science and specialization tracks in Applied AI & ML and Full Stack Development.

The Council was pleased to note this and suggested that there be sufficient focus and competence in Applied AI and track the industry trends. Another recommendation was to factor the emergence of Human-Centered AI.

The Council also suggested that there is a big need to develop competence in Blockchain Technology.

Prof. Smitha assured the Council that the specialization track of Applied Al will address many recommendations and applied in the BTech Curriculum in the higher semesters.

It was noted that developing capability in Blockchain Technology will be addressed in due course.

The Council commended the collaboration with Mu Sigma to offer the B.Sc. (Hons) Decision Science Program.
